N.B.

- Hostel facilities are provided based on criteria approved by the university since there are very limited number of facilities in the hostels.
- 2. Hostel application must be certified by the Divisional Secretary and Gramasevaka of the area for the 2nd, 3rd and 4th year (Medical Sciences) students. Hostel application of the final year students must be certified by only the Gramasevaka of the area. Applications that are not certified will be rejected.
- 3. If you are a student from a Samurdhi beneficiary family, the relevant Samurdhi certificate must be certified by the Samurdhi Officer and the Divisional Secretary of your area.
- 4. If medical reports are submitted, the relevant medical reports must be certified by a government doctor and certified by the Chief Medical Officer of the university Medical Centre.
- 5. All applicants must note that the relevant applications must submit to the Student Welfare Division by signing the book kept in the Division.
- Applications will not be accepted after due date for any reason and incomplete applications will be rejected.
- 7. Hostel facilities will not be provided to any student without hostel application form.
